WATER SHUTOFF NOTICE

Weather permitting, on **Tuesday, May 15, 2018**, our contractor plans to make a new water main connection at the intersection of Dymond Rd and Crestfield Ave. This work requires that we shut down the Crestfield water main west of Dymond.

THIS SHUT-DOWN WILL INTERRUPT WATER SERVICE TO YOUR HOME

It is anticipated that the water main will be shut down between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m., with service restored around 12:30 p.m. Moderate/heavy rain may delay this work and water shutoff until Wednesday, May 16.

Prior to 9:00 a.m. Tuesday, you should draw and store a volume of water sufficient for your needs during the outage period.

After service is restored, you might notice some minor discoloration in the water. This can result when valves are turned on and off, and lines are flushed. Opening one or more faucets and running the water for a brief period is usually all that is required to clear the lines. We recommend you verify the water is running clear before doing laundry.

We also recommend, as a precautionary measure, that you boil any water to be used for drinking or cooking, through the first 24 hours after the water is turned back on.

If you experience any problems with your water service during or after this process, please call the Public Works Department at (847) 362-3434 between 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. At other times, use the Police Non-Emergency Number (847) 362-2131, and they will contact the proper personnel for follow-up.
