### **Village of Libertyville Closes Village Hall and Other Non-Essential Offices to Public Due to COVID-19**

**Libertyville, IL-** In response to guidance from the Illinois Department of Public Health regarding the most effective strategies to prevent the spread of illness the Village of Libertyville has taken a proactive step of closing Village Hall and other Non-Essential Offices to the public effective March 16. The Libertyville Sports Complex has closed as of 5:00 p.m. on March 13. Administrative services will continue to be offered in a limited capacity by phone and e-mail. There will be no reduction in services for public safety and the Village encourages residents to conduct business online, via mail or by phone, where possible. As this situation continues to evolve, the Village will share updates to its website at [www.libertyville.com](http://www.libertyville.com) and on social media. Residents are encouraged to sign-up for Village e-news via the Village website.

During this time, limited public services will be available. Vital records will continue to be available at the Village Hall by appointment, while vehicle stickers may be purchased by using our dropbox, U.S. mail or at the Libertyville Police Department.
